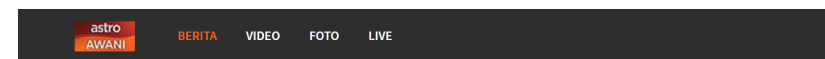

UTM Endowment Fund in need of more donations

JOHOR BARU: It is a rather challenging task for Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (UTM) to raise the targetted RM500mil for its Endowment Fund by 2020.

Its vice-chancellor Prof Datuk Abdul Wahid Omar said since the launch of the fund in 2009, only RM87mil has been raised, including cash and pledges from donors. "This figure is not encouraging as it is almost 10 years since we launched the fund," he said during the launch of Azman Hashim International Business School (AHIBS) by AmBank Group chairman Tan Sri Azman Hashim at UTM Skudai Campus here.

AHIBS was formerly known as UTM International Business School, offering courses in Management Strategic, Islamic Financial Management, Techno-Entrepreneurship, Healthcare Management and Aviation Management.

Apart from Master of Business Administration (MBA), the school also offers Doctorate in Business Administration (DBA) and doctorate programmes in business management, short-term courses and consultancy services.

Prof Wahid said there were

several issues for the slow raising of funds. "The main issue here is unattractive tax rebate or incentives for

donors. We hope to come out with solutions after discussions with the relevant authorities," he said. He said in Singapore, donors

including corporate bodies, were given double tax relief for contributing money for education related purposes.
